Where?

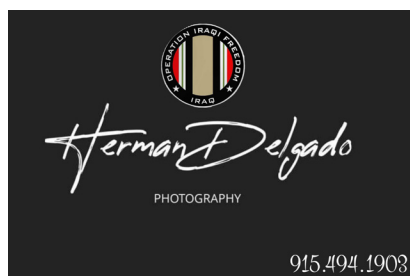
