- Ensure a full-time constable is assigned to JP 6-2, providing consistent safety and service for the court and our community, just as other JP courts receive.
- Expand access to county services at JP 6-2, including services provided by the County Tax Assessor-Collector, so our precinct is treated equitably with all other JP courts.
- Partner with local school districts to significantly reduce truancy, helping schools recover millions in lost funding while supporting students through collaboration with El Paso Community College, parents, and community stakeholders to promote graduation and workforce training opportunities.
- Implement Night Court to better serve working residents and community members who cannot attend court during standard business hours.
