EL PASO RHINOS OPEN 20TH ANNIVERSARY SEASON WITH THREE FREE GAMES FOR THE SUN CITY

Black vs. Orange intrasquad game Aug. 29 and two exhibition games vs. Odessa Jackalopes Sept. 4–5 are free to the public; regular season home opener set for Sept. 18

EL PASO, Texas — [AUG. 17, 2026] — Twenty years after the puck first dropped at the El Paso County Events Center, the El Paso Rhinos are throwing the doors open.

The Rhinos today announced that their entire 2026-27 preseason will be free to the public, beginning with the annual Black vs. Orange intrasquad scrimmage on **Saturday, August 29**, followed by back-to-back exhibition games against the **Odessa Jackalopes on Friday, September 4 and Saturday, September 5**. All three games will be played at the El Paso County Events Center. Doors open at 6pm; puck drop is at 7pm.

The free preseason kicks off a full year of celebration marking two decades of Rhinos hockey in El Paso. Founded in 2006 by former El Paso Buzzards player Cory Herman, who set out to bring the sport back to the Sun City after the Buzzards folded in 2003, the franchise has grown from a first-year expansion club into one of the most decorated junior programs in the Southwest — four Thorne Cup championships, ten-plus division titles, and, since 2021, a Tier II presence in the North American Hockey League, junior hockey's premier development league.

"We're excited about what this team brings into the new season. We've built a talented, competitive group that's ready to embrace the challenge ahead. Expectations are high, and we believe this team has the potential to do something special. We can't wait to get on the ice, compete every night, and give our fans a season they can be proud of," said Corey Heon, Rhinos President and General Manager. *Continues on page 5*
